### 5. FAST TRACK WORKFORCE INCENTIVE GRANT (for ages 25 and over)

The Fast Track Workforce Incentive Grant is a program designed to provide adults with the education and skills needed to enter the workforce in fields that are in high demand. Students must be enrolled in a designated program of study at a participating Missouri school. Apprentices must be participating in an apprenticeship in Missouri that is approved by the U.S. Department of Labor and that prepares them for employment in a high demand field as designed by the department.

You **must** create an account in [MDHEWD’s Student Portal](#) to access the application. The State Financial Aid Portal is a secure student-based website that gives Missouri students an opportunity to learn more about their own state financial aid, including scholarships and grants.
