American Welding Academy is proud to offer programs for those individuals and family members that have served in the military to protect our great country. AWA, in compliance with Section 103 of the VA Benefits and Transition Act of 2018, will not

impose any penalty, including late fees, denial of access to classes or shop time or requirement that a Chapter 31 or 33 recipient borrow additional funds to cover the individual's inability to meet his / her financial obligations to AWA due to the delayed disbursement of a payment by the US Department of Veterans Affairs.

American Welding Academy is a 23,000 sf training facility located in Union, Missouri. The building consists of 5000 sf office space with 18,000sf shop. There are a total of 64 Welding booths with separate areas for grinding, fabrication, pipe lab, classrooms and lunchroom. AWA is governed by the Administrators Rob Knoll and Adam Holt.

REFUND POLICY FOR GI BILL $\ensuremath{\mathbb{R}}$ / VA

A refund of the unused portion of tuition, fees and other charges will be made to veterans or eligible persons who fail to enter or fail to complete the course as required by Department of Veterans Affairs Regulations, CFR 21.4255.

The refund will be within 10 percent of an exact pro rata refund. No more than \$10 of the established registration fee will be retained if a veteran or eligible person fails to enter the course.

Prompt Refund: The refunded amount shall be paid within 40 days.

AWA will allow suspension of training for anyone who is readmitted to service while attending our courses. You will be allowed to pick up at the point of separation from AWA and continue your courses to completion.
